CONTRACT SOLICITATION

The United States Probation Department, District of Connecticut is soliciting bids for federal contracts to provide outpatient and/or inpatient substance abuse treatment, Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT), outpatient mental health treatment and sex offender treatment to federal offenders and pretrial defendants residing in Connecticut.

Interested agencies must be able to provide both substance abuse and mental health services to include assessments, psychiatric evaluations, outpatient individual, group, intensive outpatient counseling, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and urine collection. The ability to integrate MAT is desirable.

The United States Probation Department, District of Connecticut is also soliciting bids for federal contracts to provide inpatient, long-term and/or short-term residential substance abuse treatment.

Sex Offender programs must provide assessments, individual and group counseling. Additionally, programs must be qualified to assist in the administration and/or referral to polygraph examinations. Standalone polygraphers may submit proposals for the purposes of conducting follow-up maintenance polygraphs.

The contracts will commence on October 1, 2021.
