

Are You Eligible?

If you receive Food Stamps you may be eligible for a SNAP – E&T Scholarship. Please check the basic requirements:

- * *You must receive Food Stamps in your name for the entire time of the training program you are enrolled in.*
- * *You cannot receive cash assistance while in a selected SNAP—E&T program.*
- * *You have not received a SNAP scholarship previously. Exceptions for specific programs apply.*
- * *You do not have any outstanding balance with any state higher education institution.*

Note: Some programs require a G.E.D. or high School diploma and a Reading and/or Math assessment.
